The Pierce Public School Board of Education met for the regular meeting at 6:30 p.m. in the high school conference room. Members present were Ted Krienke, Kevin Flesner, Dave Lienemann, Robert Hoffmann and Dan Unseld. Ron Woslager was absent.

A welcome was extended to the public, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the open meetings act pointed out.

Lienemann moved and Flesner seconded a motion to excuse Woslager. Voting unanimous, motion carried.

Crystal Bauermeister informed the board about a grant from Nucor Steel and the equipment they brought for students. The equipment will be rotated between Pierce and other local schools.

Hoffmann moved and Lienemann seconded a motion to accept the consent agenda including the minutes of the previous meeting, claims, payments of bills and financial reports. Voting unanimous with Woslager absent, motion carried.

No reports from students or staff.

Mr. Sindelar's, Activities Director report included many dates and start times for sports practices and stated the the auditorium lights have been ordered, new curtains installed and stage repainted.

The Elementary School report from Mr. Patrick said there has been an increase of 10 students bringing enrollment to 352 students.

Mr. Brahmer's High School report included dates and times for fall meeting and activities.

The first discussion item was to set budget and tax request hearing. Budget hearing will be Sept. 10 at 6:00 p.m. with the tax request to follow at 6:15 p.m.

During the next discussion item a date was set for a retreat to review valuation. This will be Aug. 21, 6:30 p.m.

Superintendent Kendall Steffensen gave a preliminary budget presentation.

Lienemann moved and Flesner seconded a motion to accept the census report. Voting unanimous, motion carried.

At 7:11 Unseld moved and Lienemann seconded a motion to adjourn. Voting unanimous, motion carried.
